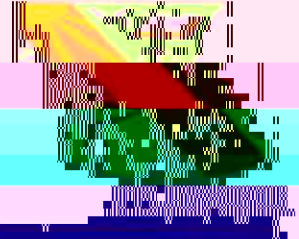

Chapter 1: Introduction to the National Curriculum Framework for School Education

Introduction

The National Curriculum Framework for School Education is designed to provide a common foundation for all school education in India.

It is based on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and aims to ensure that all students receive a high-quality education.

The framework is organized into four main areas: Foundational Skills, School Education, Higher Secondary Education, and Higher Education.

The following table provides a summary of the key components of the framework.

These skills include:

- Literacy
- Numeracy
- Communication
- Critical Thinking
- Creativity
- Physical Education
- Life Skills
- Environmental Education
- Information and Communication Technology (ICT)
